**Workers Compensation 2012 Continuing Education Course Available** 

All Delaware Workers' Compensation Health Care Payment System certified health care providers must complete a state-approved on-line course every two years in order to remain certified. The 2012 version of the course is now available at <a href="http://dowc.ingenix.com/DWC.asp">http://dowc.ingenix.com/DWC.asp</a>. The course has been updated and navigation has been streamlined. New and recertifying health care providers need to complete the course prior to their two-year anniversary in the Workers Compensation program. ### Report Employer Non-Compliance to Office of Workers' Compensation

The Office of Workers' Compensation regularly receives reports that employers do not send the mandatory employer form ("Employer's Modified Duty Availability Report"). Within 14 days of receiving the initial "Physician's Report of Workers' Compensation Injury," the employer shall provide to the health care provider/physician who issued the report, a report of the modified-duty jobs available to the employee. Physicians may report non-compliance to the Office of Workers' Compensation by submitting a letter that includes the following: employer's name, address, and phone number; date of work accident; reporting party's name, address, and phone number; and a dated copy of the "Physician's Report of Workers' Compensation Injury."

### **BCBSD Psychiatry Consultation Policy Update**

Effective March 2012, Blue Cross Blue Shield of Delaware (BCBSD) has implemented a new policy — 3.01 CA10 Primary Care Provider/Psychiatry Consultation of Care. This policy will permit reimbursement to psychiatrists and primary care providers (PCPs) for consultation and

coordination of care services related to treatment by PCPs of psychiatric conditions. Coverage is allowed for a Medical Team Conference using code 99367 when the member has a psychiatric diagnosis and the medical team includes a psychiatrist and PCP.
