ICD-10 Delay Approved!

The department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has issued a <u>final rule</u> that postpones the ICD-10 compliance deadline from October 1, 2013, to October 1, 2014. The one-year delay, originally proposed in April, allows covered entities more time to transition systems and processes to updated medical data code sets.

Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and coding organizations, such as <u>AAPC</u>, have resources to help providers prepare for a smooth transition to ICD-10. These organizations will continue to add new tools and information to their sites through the course of the transition, so visit regularly to access the latest information and training opportunities.
