# **New BCBS Delaware Reimbursement Policy for Some Injectable Medications**

Effective April 2013 Highmark BCBS of Delaware will be transitioning to a new reimbursement process for certain injectable medications.

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## **Mandatory Training for Practitioners**

As a reminder, <u>each licensing period</u> all professionals who are licensed by the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline (*nurses are not required to have this training*), i.e., physician assistants, respiratory care practitioners, paramedics, genetics counselors, acupuncture practitioners, and acupuncture detoxification specialists, as well as physicians, are required to provide an attestation on their license renewal of completion of mandatory training on the recognition of child sexual and physical abuse, exploitation, and domestic violence, and the reporting obligations under the Medical Practice Act (regarding the duty to report unprofessional conduct and the inability to practice medicine) and § 903 of Title 16. This Delaware-specific mandatory training is required by Section 1723 of the Medical Practices Act, which became effective August 1, 2010. The Medical Society of Delaware is currently working with the Child Protection Accountability Commission (CPAC) and the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline in development of combined educational content incorporating necessary updates to satisfy the mandatory training requirement. Please watch for future MSD communications which will announce the availability of the mandatory training necessary for license renewal. Current physician and physician assistant licenses expire March 31, 2013.
