# **Medicare Payments Reduction**

Medicare Fee for Service claims with dates of service or dates of discharge on or after April 1, 2013 will incur a 2 percent reduction in payment. This is due to the across the board reductions in federal spending, also known as sequestration.

The claims payment adjustment will be applied to all claims after determining coinsurance, any applicable deductible, and any applicable Medicare Secondary Payment adjustments. Though beneficiary payments for deductibles and coinsurance are not subject to the payment reduction, Medicare's payment to beneficiaries for unassigned claims is subject to the 2 percent reduction.

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

**Question:** Does the 2% payment reduction under sequestration apply to the payment rates reflected in Medicare fee-for-service fee schedules or does it only apply to the final payment amounts?

**Answer:** Payment adjustments required under sequestration are applied to all claims after determining the Medicare payment including application of the current fee schedule, coinsurance, any applicable deductible, and any applicable Medicare Secondary Payment adjustments. All fee schedules, Pricers, etc., are unchanged by sequestration; it's only the final payment amount that is reduced.

## **Annual DMAP On-line Disclosure Form Process Started**

Effective March 18, 2013, ALL practitioners are required to submit their annual Provider Disclosure Statement. The online form is now available on the DMAP website. All disclosure forms must be completed by May 3, 2013.

Practitioners will have thirty five business days to complete their annual Provider Disclosure Statement. If the form has not been submitted by May 3, 2013, your payments will be suspended.
